Police put a break on the waywardness of people

DHARWAD, DHMS

After coming under the hammer from the media and the general public for allowing the public to go for hospitalised people during the first day of lockdown relaxation on Thursday, imposed more stricter rules on the second day of lockdown relaxation on Friday.
